Your Club's Plan for Practices & Other In-Person Activities

We are a part of College Disc Golf. We will use our GroupMe to communicate back and forth between who will and will not be attending practices. At this point in time, not all practices will be full team practices. 6 feet social distancing will be applied at all practices as they are outdoors. There will be no car-pooling and each member is responsible for their own transportation. Policies and protocols will be sent out by the VP and through the multiple club group messages we are active in. As new members try to join the club, they will be automatically met with a reply of how to join along with a document stating all of the steps that are being taken to reduce risks of a Covid-19 transmission. The current and past members who still participate within our active group messages will be sent each an individual list of guidelines to follow while on the course. If not responsive to these digital methods, they will be verbally transmitted at the next practice or gathering. There will be a fine to members who are not willing to adhere by the basic guidelines that are put in place for the first account. If there are three acts that go against the guidelines, they will be suspended from RDGC and all club related activities.

Attendance and service hours are both suspended for the fall semester. We have been keeping track of remote players by tracking their player statistics on both UDisc (mobile app) and PDGA.com and will continue to do so.

I feel positive about our clubs recruitment this year. We will become more active in all of the local disc golf forums, which is where you will typically find people who genuinely want to play. We will also recruit as we see students out and about playing by providing them contact information.
